1911 and became a telegraph boy at the same time. He served the army for some years before getting back to his work in post offices. By the time he retired, he had worked for post offices for 45 years. In his later life, Kimura lived with his eldest son's family and helped his son run the family farm. Subsequently, Kimura lived with his eldest grandson's family for the rest of his life.
