programme. Such pr	rogrammes offer p	olenty of opportunity for	on-the-job training and work experience.			
Programmes usually	last between two a	nd three and a half years a	and comprise theoretical as well as practical			
elements. You will sp	pend one or two da	ys a week, or several weel	ks at once, at a vocational school where you			
will acquire the theor	retical knowledge t	hat you will need in your	future occupation. The rest of the time will			
be spent at a compar	ny. There you get t	o apply your newly acqu	ired knowledge in practice, for example by			
learning to operate m	achinery. You will	get to know what your co	ompany does, learn how $\underline{it}$ operates and find			
out if you can see you	urself working ther	e after completing your tr	aining.			
This combination of	theory and practi	ce gives you a real head	start into your job: by the time you have			
completed your train	ning, you will not	only have the required te	chnical knowledge, but you will also have			
<u>hands-on</u> experience in your job. There are around 350 officially recognised training programmes in						
Germany, so chances	s are good that one	of them will suit your in	terests and talents. You can find out which			
one that might be by visiting one of the jobs and vocational training fairs which are organised in many German						
cities at different tim	es in the year.					
Employment prospec	ets for students who	have completed a dual vo	ocational training programme are very good.			
This is one of the reasons why this kind of training is very popular with young Germans: around two thirds of						
all students leaving s	chool go on to star	t a vocational training pro	gramme.
