Youth are the driving force of a nation. Known as the most worth-living-and-visiting city in Viet Nam, Da Nang has successfully involved its young and dynamic residents in the development of the city. A students' group from the University of Da Nang came up with the project of constructing traffic culture in the City of Bridges. Awarded among the Top 10 "Viet Nam's voluntary projects" by the Central Committee of Ho Chi Minh Communist Youth Union in 2020, the project aims to raise public awareness about traffic rules, change behaviours of young people and the community and create a safe, civilized and friendly traffic environment. The highlight of the project is the companionship of foreign tourists with volunteer students. They guide the tourists in road traffic at major intersections during rush hours and answer their questions of traffic during their stay in Viet Nam.
