A students' group from the University of Da Nang came up with the project of constructing traffic culture in the City of Bridges. Awarded among the Top 10 "Viet Nam's voluntary projects" by the Central Committee of Ho Chi Minh Communist Youth Union in 2020, the project aims to raise public awareness about traffic rules, change behaviours of young people and the community and create a safe, civilized and friendly traffic environment.
