Noise pollution is an invisible danger. It is considered to be any unwanted or disturbing sound that affects the health and well-being of humans and other organisms.

Noise pollution impacts millions of people. The most common **one** is Noise Induced Hearing Loss (NIHL). It can also cause high blood pressure, heart disease, sleep disturbances, and stress. These health problems can affect all age groups, especially children. Many children who live near noisy airports or streets suffer from stress and impairments in memory, attention level, and reading skill.

Noise pollution also impacts the health and well-being of wildlife. Animals use sound for a variety of reasons, including to navigate, find food, attract mates, and avoid predators. Noise pollution makes it difficult for them to accomplish these tasks, which affects **their** ability to survive.

Increasing noise is not only affecting animals on land, it is also a growing problem for those that live in the ocean. Whales and dolphins are particularly impacted by noise pollution. These marine mammals rely on **echolocation** to communicate, navigate, feed, and find mates, and excess noise interferes with their ability to effectively echolocate.
