Too Much Tech? A Look into Teen Lives

Teenagers use technology more than ever – but is it controlling their lives? As part of BBC School Report's News Day, three teenagers describe the impact technology and social media have on their sleep, relationships, and free time.

Heather, 15 - Priory School, Portsmouth

Heather spends one to three hours daily on Facebook, which is less than many of her friends. She uses her laptop for studying but often keeps social media open at the same time. While she prefers reading books over looking at screens at night, she admits it's easy to lose track of time. She's not interested in having the latest phone and believes carrying expensive gadgets can be unsafe. Interestingly, her dad is more into new tech than she is.

Sadia, 11 - Our Lady's Convent High School, Hackney

Sadia owns several devices and sometimes chats with friends at night, but she says it doesn't affect her sleep. Her mum limits her screen time and often reminds her to read. Although technology has reduced how often she plays outdoors, it helps her stay connected with relatives living abroad. She prefers texting to meeting friends in person but agrees that face-to-face time is more enjoyable.

Olivia, 14 – Tarporley High School, Cheshire

Olivia sees phones as status symbols. She isn't on Facebook but uses Twitter and is careful about what she posts. She sets her own screen-time limits and tries to be disciplined. Olivia notices that many teens stay online late at night, endlessly browsing. Although she enjoys technology, she values real-life interactions and doesn't want to be labelled an "anti-social teenager."
