The rose also held a special significance to this because if the Beast didn't learn to love and be loved in return by the time the last rose petal fell, he and the other inhabitants would be stuck the way they are forever. Of course, you already know this if you've seen the original film, but I really find it to be a good example of how fantasy comes to life in this story.
